Customers who receive water deliveries for agricultural purposes under this schedule, and who present evidence to the utility that such deliveries qualify for the lower pump tax rates levied by the Santa Clara Valley Water District for agricultural water, shall receive a credit of \$1.1559 per 100 cubic feet on each water bill for the quantities of water used during the period covered by that bill.

4. To fund the repayment of a Safe Drinking Water State Revolving Fund loan, pursuant to D.03-07-013 dated July 10, 2003, a monthly surcharge will be added to the bill as follows:

6. To offset the increase in Pump Tax from the Santa Clara Valley Water District, effective July 1, 2007, a surcharge of \$0.0439 per 100 cu.ft. is to be added to the Quantity Rate.

7. To offset the increase in Purchased Water from the Santa Clara Valley Water District, effective August 1, 2008, a surcharge of \$0.0510 per 100 cu.ft. is to be added to the Quantity Rate.

8. To offset the increase in Pump Tax from the Santa Clara Valley Water District, effective August 1, 2008, a surcharge of \$0.0494 per 100 cu.ft. is to be added to the Quantity Rate.

9. To fund the repayment of a Safe Drinking Water State Revolving Fund loan, pursuant to D.03-07-013 dated July 10, 2003, a monthly surcharge will be added to the bill as follows:
