We also announced the top 50 [Corporate Philanthropists](#) at last night's event in Campbell.

In 2024, the median amount given to Silicon Valley charities by the 36 companies on our recent list was \$3,391,840. Total amount these companies gave to charities in Silicon Valley was \$122,106,229, with the Top 3 companies on this year's Business Journal List gave a combined total of \$81,253,334 to local charities. The other 33 gave a total of \$40,852,895.
