

AMI METERS: WHAT DO I NEED TO KNOW?



Many SJW customers have been asking us for Advanced Metering Infrastructure (AMI) technology. We are working with the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) to deliver on this request for the communities we serve. We look forward to

sharing any new developments on this exciting new technology.

AMI – sometimes referred to as "smart meters" – transforms the way customers and utilities can monitor water usage by securely sending usage data over a wireless communications network on an hourly basis, where it is stored in a cloud-based system. In contrast, your meters are currently read manually once every two months.



Some of the benefits of AMI for our customers include:



Convenience: 24/7 real-time access to your water consumption using a secure app or online portal from wherever you are. For example, monitor while you are on vacation.



Control Over Billing: Tools to help you manage your usage and water bill. You will be able to compare your water usage on a daily, weekly and monthly basis, allowing you to adjust how much water you use and manage your consumption.



Leak Detection: Early stage detection and notification of leaks and spikes in water usage — helping to save you money and potentially avoid costly property damage.



Water Conservation: Tools to help you promote sustainability by using your water more intentionally and efficiently.



Improved Customer Service: With more accurate data, we can help you resolve any water usage or billing issues more quickly and accurately.

With COVID-19 cases fluctuating, SJW remains vigilant and fully operational in accordance with County and State directives. Crews required in the field continue to follow all standard safety and health protocols. Those on the Bascom campus are subject to health screenings prior to entering the facility.

Main replacement and other major infrastructure projects have resumed, keeping us on target for upgrading 24 miles of pipeline



in 2020. We thank all of our dedicated crews and staff for keeping operations running smoothly through this unprecedented time.
