
### San Jose Water At a Glance



- Established in 1866, serves approximately one million people in the San Jose area
- Largest investor-owned water utility in California with a contiguous service area
- Service area
  - 138 square miles
  - 2,400 miles of mains
  - . 235,000 customer accounts




### Customer Breakdown by Type







### San Jose Water – Water Sources



Water Sources




### Imported Water to Your Tap






### Current Reservoir Conditions & Drought Monitor









### **Recent Conservation Regulations**

- AB 1668 and SB 606 (2018) create Water Use Efficiency Standards
- Establishes Water Use Objective for Utilities:
  - Indoor use standards
    - 55 gallons per person per day (GPCD) in 2025
    - 47.5 GPCD by 2030
    - 42 GPCD going forward after 2030
  - Outdoor water use budgets determined by irrigable landscape areas.
  - Commercial, Industrial, and Institutional Best Management Practices
  - Accounting of water company system leaks.





### 2021 Drought Update

- June 9<sup>th</sup>: Valley Water calls for 15% conservation cutbacks from 2019 levels
- July 8<sup>th</sup>: Governor Newsom calls for statewide conservation efforts
- July 12<sup>th</sup> : Santa Clara County calls for drought emergency
- SJW asks customers to reduce water usage by 15% from 2019 levels
- Water use restrictions in place
- If targets are not met by August 31<sup>st</sup>, SJW may need to implement water contingency plan with allocations and drought surcharges.



### SJW's Drought Response

- Activated our Stage 3 Drought Level according to our Water Shortage Contingency Plan
  - Outreach to customers on water use restrictions via social media, website, direct mail and media
- Filed Schedule 14.1 Water Shortage Contingency Plan <u>UPDATE</u> with California Public Utilities Commission
  - Outlines our updated plan but not an implementation schedule.





### SJW's Drought Response

- Outreach to customers on water use restrictions and individual 2019 usage
- Continued best management practices to reduce water waste in our operations:
  - Quick leak response
  - · Advanced leak detection
  - Flushing truck with closed loop system
  - · Infrastructure investments





### Water Use Rules and Water Waste Violations



#### Water only 2 days per week:

- Odd # addresses: Monday & Thursday
- Even # addresses: Tuesday & Friday



**Limit filling** of decorative fountains and ornamental lakes/ponds.



Water **no more than 15 minutes** per day.



Water in the **very early** morning or late evening.



Wash cars at a commercial car washing facility that recycles water.

### Water Conservation Inspection in Action




- Focus on outdoor water conservation
- Provide customized watering schedules
- Adjust irrigation timers, if needed
- Provide tools to find toilet leaks
- Educate homeowner on tools to find leaks




### Water Saving Tips: Indoor

- Fix or report leaks
- Check toilets for leaks as they are the #1
  cause of leaks on a property
- Take 5 minute showers
- Turn off water when brushing teeth
- Wash only full loads of clothes and use a front loading or other water efficient washing machine
- When replacing washing machines purchase the most efficient model



### Water Saving Tips: Outdoor

- Check irrigation system periodically for leaks and breaks
- Check controller clocks have functioning batteries to prevent loss of schedules
- Use mulch and cut grass to higher lengths to prevent water loss
- Run irrigation systems (pop-up sprayheads) no more than 5 minutes at a time to prevent runoff
