Service Charge Change San Jose Water has changed the way it calculates your

monthly service charge. Instead of a flat fee per month based on your meter size, the calculation will be based on the actual number of billing days in your billing cycle and your meter size. This is not a rate increase. The California Public Utilities Commission has directed San Jose Water to calculate the service charge in a new way.


