Advice Letter No. 597

To Whom It May Concern:

San Jose Water Company (U-168-W) (SJWC) hereby requests authority from the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) to highlight the changes in tariff schedules applicable to its service area which are attached :

Purpose

These tariffs are submitted pursuant to General Orders (G.O.) Nos. 96-B, Water Industry Rules 4.3, 7.3.2.(2) and 8.3. This advice letter is designated a Tier II Advice Letter in compliance with General Order 96-B, Water Industry Rule 7.3.2.(2).

By this filing SJWC submits an interruptible special contract (Attachment A) for Commission approval. This contract satisfies the five standards established in Commission Resolution W-3937, dated September 7, 1995 (W-3937). Consequently, this advice letter proposes to add this contract to SJWC's "*List of Contracts and Deviations*" tariff sheet.

The Domestic Water Contract for Interruptible Service (Contract) being submitted with this filing (Attachment A) requests interruptible domestic water service to one parcel on Old Santa Cruz Highway within the unincorporated area of the County of Santa Clara. This parcel is owned by Edgar Enrique Cauich Zermeno with no access to water in his parcel. A service connection has been requested for the parcel. Exhibit A of Attachment A shows the location of this property (APN 558-08-147) where the new service connection would be installed on Old Santa Cruz Highway within SJWC's Mountain District service area.

The owner of this parcel is willing to accept an interruptible service as dictated by the contract. Because of this situation, SJWC is willing in this case to provide service on a limited basis for the well-being of the parcel owner. To minimize impacts to existing Mountain District customers, the service will include a flow limiter to limit peak flow at the service to 10 gallons per minute.

Pursuant to the contract the owner will be charged for water service pursuant to SJWC's Schedule No. 1, "*General Metered Service*" or its successor tariff that may be in place from time to time. The services pursuant to this contract will also be subject to any other rate restrictions that may be imposed by tariff as a result of drought conditions (Rule 14.1 or Schedule 14.1) or any other special unforeseen condition. Note that this will not be a service area extension, but rather provision of an interruptible service to a independent customer outside of SJWC's service area.

Resolution W-3937 established the following five criteria for submitting special contracts for interruptible service approval through an Advice Letter:

- (1) *The customer cannot be served at G.O 103 standards at a reasonable cost,*
- (2) *The customer is willing to take service at less than G.O. 103 standards,*
- (3) *The limitations will be recorded as a deed restriction,*
- (4) *The residence to be served is in an area in which additional growth is unlikely, and*
- (5) *The final installation, including customer-provided facilities, meets all local permit requirements.*

The domestic water service proposed in this contract satisfies the five criteria as shown below:

- (1) These parcels can be served at G.O. 103 standards for pressure and location. However, in order to minimize impacts to existing Mountain District customers, the service will include a flow limiter to limit peak flow at the service to 10 gallons per minute.
- (2) As provided in the Contract, the owner is willing to take service at less than GO 103A standards.
- (3) A copy of the deed restriction to be filed is included as Attachment A to the Contract.
- (4) The parcels to be served is in an area where additional growth is unlikely due to the wooded terrain and lot size building limitations by the County of Santa Clara.
- (5) Permitting related to the installation of this service will be at the owner's request through the County of Santa Clara.

As required by GO 96B, Water Industry Rule 8.3, the Contract contains the provision that:

"This Contract may not become effective until it is approved by the California Public Utilities Commission ("CPUC"). This Contract at all times shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the CPUC, and hence, to any modifications as the CPUC may direct from time to time in the exercise of its jurisdiction."

Effective Date

SJWC requests an effective date of July 14, 2023

Protests and Responses

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. A response does not oppose the filing but presents information that may prove useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds may include the following:

- 1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;
- 2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- 3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material error or omissions;
- 4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding;
- 5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or
- 6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a prior order of the Commission).

A response or protest must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by the Water Division within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. The address for mailing or delivering a protest is:

The advice letter process does not provide for any responses, protests or comments, except for the utility's reply, after the 20-day comment period. Public notice is not required.

SJWC Currently has Advice Letters 590, 592, and 596 pending before the Commission.

This filing will not cause the withdrawal of service, nor conflict with other schedules or rules.

DOMESTIC WATER CONTRACT
FOR INTERRUPTIBLE SERVICE

Edgar Enrique Cauich Zermeno (“Owner”) as the owner of APN 558-08-147 for a residence to be located at 22045 Old Santa Cruz Highway within the unincorporated area of the County of Santa Clara is hereby offered the right to purchase domestic water from San Jose Water Company (“Utility”) upon acknowledgement and acceptance of the following terms and conditions (the “Contract”):

1. Water delivery to the Owner will consist of and be limited to one General Metered Service (Service), only, to be sized at $\frac{3}{4}$ ". The rate charged for the readiness to serve charge, water charges and any other applicable charges and special conditions will be as set forth in the Utility's regular tariff for domestic water for the Mountain District or its successor tariff that may be in place from time to time. The services pursuant to this Contract will also be subject to any other rate restrictions that may be imposed by tariff (such as the implementation of Schedule 14.1) as a result of drought conditions or any other special unforeseen condition.
2. The location of the $\frac{3}{4}$ " Service will be on Old Santa Cruz Highway in the vicinity of 22065 Old Santa Cruz Highway (APN 558-08-148) at a place mutually agreed upon by the Owner and Utility. The cost of installing this service shall be borne by the Owner.
3. The Owner is outside of Utility's current filed service area.
4. As conditions of the delivery of water to Owner under this Contract, Owner agrees to (i) provide and install cross-connection and backflow prevention devices as required by Utility, and to (ii) provide and install any and all pumping and electrical facilities that Owner may require to receive the delivery of water from Utility. Owner agrees that it will operate and maintain all devices and facilities required under this paragraph 4.
5. Delivery of water to Owner under this Contract, is conditional upon and subject to interruption as dictated by Utility as follows:
 - a) Owner will cease taking water through the $\frac{3}{4}$ " Service when requested by Utility, either in writing or by verbal request, for any reason whatsoever.
 - b) Water pressure provided by Utility may vary from time to time.
6. Owner to agree to file with the County Recorder's Office of the County of Santa Clara, prior to receiving service, a covenant in the form of Exhibit A, attached hereto, indicating the execution of this Contract.
7. This Contract may not become effective until it is approved by the California Public Utilities Commission (“CPUC”). This Contract at all times shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the CPUC, and hence, to any modifications as the CPUC may direct from time to time in the exercise of its jurisdiction.

8. If, in the future, improvements are made to the water system of Utility such that the Service becomes a standard service instead of an interruptible service, Utility will so notify Owner.

PRESSURE & LOCATION COVENANT FOR DOMESTIC WATER SERVICE

WHEREAS, **Edgar Enrique Cauich Zermeno**, is the "Owner" of all that real property in the County of Santa Clara, State of California described as APN 558-08-147 (Property), and;

WHEREAS, it is the desire of San Jose Water Company to impose the following restrictions pertaining to Domestic Water Service with respect to said Property which restriction will benefit and burden said Property, each owner, and successor owners thereto as a covenant running with the land;

NOW THEREFORE said Property shall hereinafter be burdened and obligated to San Jose Water Company, a California corporation, successor in interest to San Jose Water Works, a California corporation in exchange for domestic water service as follows:

THE OWNER, and their successor and assigns acknowledge, accept and agree that General Metered Service for the Property may be obtained from the San Jose Water Company by a service connection provided on Old Santa Cruz Highway in front of 22065 Old Sana Cruz Highway (APN 558-08-148); that such General Metered Service will be at water pressures below the standards now required by the California Public Utilities Commission and its General Order 103 and that private auxiliary pumping will be needed to provide adequate pressure on the Property; that the Owner agrees to accept this low-pressure water service at the location indicated and at normal tariffed rates for General Metered Service; that such water pressure is not subject to improvement by San Jose Water Company; that the Owner waive any and all objection to such level of service from San Jose Water Company; that to obtain such limited service, Owner will, if necessary, install, maintain and repair, on property where permission has been granted, a private service line to the Property and that Owner will provide, maintain and repair cross-connection and/or backflow prevention devices as required by the San Jose Water Company, and that Owner will locate, on property where permission has been granted, any and all pumping, storage and electrical facilities Owner may find necessary, and will operate, maintain and repair the same.

This covenant is subject to any and all prior rights of record in favor of third parties and owner makes no warranty as to the extent of its title to the subject property.

Getting paper copies

At any time, you may request from us a paper copy of any record provided or made available electronically to you by us. You will have the ability to download and print documents we send to you through the DocuSign system during and immediately after the signing session and, if you elect to create a DocuSign account, you may access the documents for a limited period of time (usually 30 days) after such documents are first sent to you. After such time, if you wish for us to send you paper copies of any such documents from our office to you, you will be charged a \$0.00 per-page fee. You may request delivery of such paper copies from us by following the procedure described below.

Withdrawing your consent

If you decide to receive notices and disclosures from us electronically, you may at any time change your mind and tell us that thereafter you want to receive required notices and disclosures only in paper format.
