### Children's Discovery Museum Little WaterWays Exhibit

The Little WaterWays exhibit at the Children's Discovery Museum in San Jose is a small indoor water park designed for little kids to explore ways in which water pressure and gravity influence the direction water flows. The system, custom-designed and installed by SJW many years ago, features a 10 HP pump and recirculates 850 gallons of water every five minutes, passing through two separate filtration systems, followed by two sanitation systems. A recent power outage at the museum caused the exhibit to go down, which posed a challenge for Senior Control Systems Planner, Jim Alexander, and his team. However, we're happy to report that the SJW team has the exhibit back up and running! Big shoutout to Jim for getting this unique and special exhibit in our community fully operational for years to come.

# Notice of Water Source Change

In early October, a water quality notice went out to approximately 10,000 customers about a change in water source, thanks to McLaughlin station being brought online. Due to this change, customers may experience some differences in their water quality which include:

- Water which is not fluoridated. The water customers were previously receiving was fluoridated.
- Harder water, which might include a change in taste and odor.

To address the change in fluoridation, SJW has worked with the County Public Health Department to fund and build a fluoridation facility at our McLaughlin groundwater station. We expect to have the fluoridation system up and running in Spring 2024, at which time fluoride concentrations will be restored
