To Whom It May Concern:

San Jose Water Company (U-168-W) (SJWC) hereby transmits for filing the following changes in tariff schedules applicable to its service area and which are attached here to:

These tariffs are submitted pursuant to General Order No. 96-B. Pursuant to General Order No. 96-B Water Industry Rule 7.3.2.(4), this advice letter is designated a Tier II Advice Letter.

Purpose

SJWC hereby respectfully requests authorization to establish an opt-out tariff for Advance Metering Infrastructure (AMI).

The authorization of an AMI opt-out tariff was provided in Decision No. (D.) 22-08-013.

Background

Per the Settlement Agreement between SJWC and the Public Advocates Office (Cal Advocates) authorized in Commission D.22-08-013 Section C.a.(2):

Customers/subscribers can opt-out of the AMI program and associated engagement at their discretion and the opted-out customer/subscribers shall be excluded from any enrollment calculation.

Once AMI is fully deployed, SJWC will no longer be manually reading meters. However, if a customer decides to opt-out of AMI, they will have to pay a monthly fee for manual meter reading services. For 2024, the meter reading fee is \$25/month and the meter removal fee is \$36.

SJWC will file a Tier 1 advice letter annually to adjust rates in accordance with the labor inflation rate published by the Public Advocates Office.

Protests and Responses

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. A response does not oppose the filing but presents information that may prove useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds may include the following:

- 1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;
- 2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- 3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material error or omissions;
- 4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding;
- 5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or
- 6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a prior order of the Commission).

A response or protest must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by the Water Division within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. The address for mailing or delivering a protest is:
