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Fix A Leak Week (March 18-24, 2024)

Household leaks waste nearly 1 trillion gallons of water annually nationwide, so each year we hunt down the drips during Fix a Leak Week. The average household's leaks can account for nearly 10,000 gallons of water wasted every year. Ten percent of homes have leaks that waste 90 gallons or more per day, according to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. Common types of leaks found in the home are worn toilet flappers, dripping faucets, and other leaking valves. These types of leaks are often easy to fix, requiring only a few tools and hardware that can pay for themselves in water savings. Fixing easily corrected household water leaks can save homeowners about 10 percent on their water bills.

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Military Family Relief Program

SJW is proud to support members of the armed forces. If you or your spouse are called to full-time active military service by the President of the United States or the Governor of California during a time of declared national or state emergency or war, you may apply for a 180-day-period shut-off protection for your water service.

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Inspiring Change through Supplier Diversity in the Water Industry

SJW's Director of Supplier Diversity, Tim McLaughlin, spoke with the Western Regional Minority Supplier Development Council for the SF Business Times on the importance of supplier diversity. 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SJW Installs Solar at Bascom Facility

SJW recently installed solar panels and charging stations at our Bascom offices. Thus far in 2024, SJW solar panels have produced 137.6 MWh — equivalent to about \$34,300 in savings, or the carbon sequestered by 12.5 acres of U.S. forests in one year.




Third-Party Notification
