


Who we are

FOUNDED IN 1866, San Jose Water is an investor-owned

public utility, and one of the largest and most technically sophisticated urban water systems in the United States. We serve over 1 million people in the greater San Jose metropolitan area with high quality, life sustaining water and an emphasis on exceptional customer service.

San Jose Water is a subsidiary of SJW Group, a publicly traded company listed on the New York Stock Exchange under the symbol SJW. Other regulated subsidiaries of SJW Group include: Connecticut Water Company in Connecticut; Maine Water Company in Maine; and Texas Water Company in Texas.

San Jose Water's 140 square-mile service area includes the cities of San Jose, Cupertino, Campbell, Monte Sereno, Saratoga, Los Gatos, and unincorporated portions of Santa Clara



County. This includes 2,400 miles of water mains, 106 tanks and reservoirs, over 20,000 hydrants and more than 35,000 valves. We deliver water from three major sources: groundwater, imported surface water and local mountain surface water.

Primarily SCVWD Imported Surface Water









According to the Value of Water campaign and the Sierra Club, every \$1M of investment generates 15 jobs.


