SJW Meter Shop Solves Mystery

SJW's Meter Shop recently hosted technology partners Neptune and MARS to help uncover an issue surrounding over-registering water at high flows with the new large Sensus Mach 10 meters. The source of the issue was found at two automated valves at the water tank outside the meter shop. Over time, the tank drain closing time increased. Changing the 7-second drain closing time to 30 seconds allowed plenty of time for the drain valve to close before the discharge valve opened. Mystery solved! Thank you to Anh Tran, Meter Shop Superintendent, the entire Meter Shop Staff and our partners from Neptune and MARS for ensuring meters are tested and working properly so our customers can receive accurate bills.

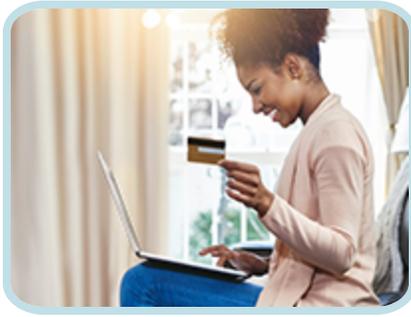


SJW Fun Facts!

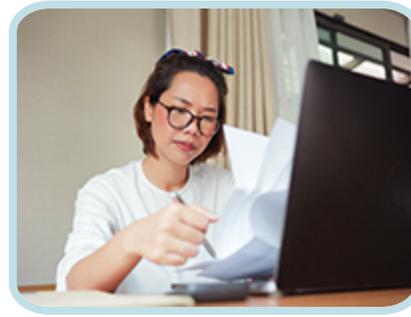




Pay Your Bill Online
