## Water Quality Corner: Lead and Copper Sampling Underway

San Jose Water is currently conducting our routine Lead and Copper Rule sampling as part of our ongoing commitment to providing high-quality drinking water. We've reached out to 100 homes across our service area to collect samples from customer taps, helping us monitor water quality directly at the point of use. This sampling, which will occur twice this year, helps verify that our water is not contributing to the release of lead or copper from household plumbing materials. Results are analyzed by certified laboratories and are used to confirm continued compliance with strict state and federal standards. We're grateful to our participating customers for supporting this important effort. Results will be shared with those who provided samples and summarized in next year's Water Quality Report.

### **Project Spotlight: Distribution System Sample Stations**


