SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. Customers who receive water deliveries for agricultural purposes under this schedule, and who present evidence to the utility that such deliveries qualify for the lower pump tax rates levied by the Santa Clara Valley Water District for agricultural water, shall receive a credit of \$5.0257 per 100 cubic feet on each water bill for the quantities of water used during the period covered by that bill.
2. All bills are subject to the reimbursement fee set forth in Schedule No. UF.
3. To fund the Customer Assistance Program (CAP) for residential low-income households, a surcharge of \$2.61 per month will be added to the bill. (I)
4. To fund the repayment of a Safe Drinking Water State Revolving Fund Loan, pursuant to D.05-01-048 dated January 27, 2005, a monthly surcharge will be added to the bill as follows: (D) (T)
